Further Details and Policies:

UNIFORM POLICY

ALL Titans competitive athletes are required to have a Titans bathing suit (the new black/red/yellow version), to be worn during tournaments and games with other clubs. Both men's and women's suits will be stocked and will be available during occasional merchandise sales over the season, the first one being during the Titans Open House on September 13th. Cost is \$100 for women's and \$55 for men's payable by cheque to Titans Water Polo or cash only to the Merchandise Coordinator.

ALL Titans competitive athletes are required to have a black Titans jacket, to be worn traveling to and from tournaments, and during other club activities. The cost will be approximately \$55. They are the same jackets as the ones purchased by many athletes over the past two seasons. These will be by special order and sample sizes will be available at a number of times/locations, including at the Titans Open House on September 13th. Optional matching wind pants will also be available for purchase.

PURCHASE OF WATER POLO BALLS

ALL Titans Academy athletes will be required to have their own water polo ball, to be brought to each practice. Balls will be available at all of the merchandise sales. Athletes should clearly mark their full name on their ball in indelible ink, so they can identify their ball.

All purchases are payable by cheque to Titans Water Polo or cash only to the Merchandise Coordinator.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The Titans **Code of Conduct** approved in August 2008 by the Board of Directors, is in effect. All members will be required to sign that they have read and understood the terms of this document. The Code of Conduct can be found on the Titans website (www.titanswaterpolo.ca) under the Competitive Programs.

In case of any alteration to the Code of Conduct, all members will be notified by e-news and it will be their responsibility to read and understand those changes.

Mandatory volunteer requirements for each family:

The Club relies on volunteers to keep fees as low as possible and to ensure the success of Club events and programs. **Each family** is asked to volunteer for one of the positions listed below. All **16+U/ 18+U athletes** are required to volunteer at least once as a referee at the ILWP, Academy or Rec House League game nights. Don't worry, training will be provided.

PARENTS please review the list below and notify Valerie Walker, Competitive Program Manager (INFO@titanswaterpolo.ca) as to which position you wish to volunteer for:

Team Manager (TM) - EACH of our competitive teams requires a parent volunteer to manage e-mail communication, to set up team meetings, and to coordinate logistics for tournaments. In terms of tournament planning (travel, budget, accommodations, player fees, etc), the TM can choose to do tasks themselves, or can delegate the task to other parent(s) on the team. Team Managers report to and are supported by Competitive Program Manager, Valerie Walker. Teams who don't have a team manager will not be able to participate in tournaments.

Merchandise Coordinator - position already filled.

Tournament Chairs - We require a parent Chair (or two co-chairs) for Titans hosted tournaments. These individuals are responsible for working with the Competitive Program Manager to set the budget, to recruit key volunteers, for liaison with visiting teams, and to generally oversee the event. This year Titans will be hosting three tournaments: Titans Bantam Cup, Titans Cadet Cup and International tournament.

Hospitality Room Coordinators – We require a parent to run the hospitality room (food and drink donations are used to feed officials/ volunteers/ coaches attending the tournament) at each Titans hosted tournament. This individual manages the hospitality room by soliciting and organizing all donations of food and other items (**sorry, donating to the hospitality room does not count as a volunteer commitment!**) and is responsible for set-up and clean-up and organizing volunteers.

Minor Officials – Parents are needed to volunteer at Titans hosted tournaments to work as minor officials, running shot clock and game clocks and being game secretary. Training will be provided to ensure volunteers are comfortable with their roles. We expect that ALL parents of participating Titans athletes will help out. Parents are also needed to help with set-up and take-down of all equipment prior to tournaments.

Weekly E-News Coordinator - position already filled.

Communications and Marketing Volunteers - a number of parents are needed to assist with Club communications and marketing, including researching and writing short articles for the e-news; researching and writing athlete and coach profiles for the website; becoming a media liaison, etc. If you like to write, please contact us, as we have a job for you! This is a 'less regular' volunteer role that we can build to suit your skills and availability.

Communications and Media - We require a media person for each of the tournaments we are hosting (listed above) to contact media and send them schedules. Also, general 'writers' needed to do regular press releases and start building relationships with media (neighborhood community papers, Citizen, Sun, radio, TV). We have templates and contact information ready to hand over.

Ottawa Water Polo League (AA) Coordinator - Titans Water Polo is taking a lead role in organizing an AA version of OWPL. The men's team(s) will participate in this league. A parent volunteer is required to help us organize logistics and to administer the program.

Chaperones - All teams will require chaperones (and drivers, if the team is not using a bus) for any out-of-town tournament. The team budget will pay for the chaperones' transportation and accommodations (and in the case of drivers, reimburse you for mileage or gas). These volunteers will be recruited by Team Managers. If there are not enough volunteers for these roles, the teams will not be able to travel. Please make an effort to help out your son or daughter's team. Police checks will be required, available through the Titans.

End of Year Banquet Coordinator(s) - Plan and organize the June 2010 Awards Banquet, including sponsorship, tickets, budget, etc.

25th Anniversary Gala Coordinator(s) - The Titans Club was incorporated in 1984 and celebrated its 25th anniversary in February, 2009. The Club would like to mark this memorable occasion with a Gala inviting past and present Club athletes, coaches, board members, etc. One or more coordinators will be needed to organize this event.

Also, there are many instances where our athletes participate in league play or in scrimmages with other teams and within the club, where we require some game setup (game clock, shot clock, etc) as well as people to run the clocks and keep score. We would welcome new parents to these roles, and would encourage everyone to 'do their share' as a family. After all, we are a volunteer organization, and if we have to hire people to take on these odd jobs, then registration fees will only get higher. If you've never done it before, don't worry, we have lots of other parents who would be willing to help you learn the ropes!

Important Notes About Registration 2009-2010:

About Registration

All registrants are required to be in good financial standing with the Ottawa Titans in order to be covered by our mandatory insurance through Water Polo Canada. Registration is not final until all forms are completed and returned to the Club along with required payments. Even if you are a returning athlete, you must complete and sign all forms.

Athletes must be fully registered and must be members in good standing to participate at practices. Any athlete that has not submitted their registration material and payment by September 30th will not be allowed to participate in the practice until this is complete.

New Competitive Athletes, please note that we require a copy of proof of birth date.

Let us know if you do not wish your contact information shared for car pooling purposes.

About Fees

Titans Water Polo is a not-for-profit, volunteer run sports organization. We cannot and do not make a profit. Registration fees cover costs only. Aquatic sports have significant costs that include pool rental, lifeguards, coaching staff and equipment such as balls, caps, nets, etc. Titans Water Polo program costs are not subsidized and we must be self-sufficient.

We rely heavily on volunteers to keep our costs, and thus your fees, as low as possible. We expect all families to volunteer with the Club in some capacity.

Club Communications

E-mail is the principal mode of communication within the Club. Team Managers use e-mail regularly to communicate with their teams. Weekly e-news bulletins are sent out to members to communicate recent developments/ activities, or to update the membership on club news. The principle email address given at registration should be one that is checked frequently by at least one parent or adult player. There may be last-minute schedule changes, and often a reply is requested, especially prior to tournaments. We understand that some parents may not wish to receive water polo email at work, but we ask for a second email address because sometimes there are technical difficulties. Please indicate on the forms if you would like routine email notices sent to more than one email address.

If your contact information changes during the season, please inform both the Club Registrar (registrar@titanswaterpolo.ca) and your Team Manager.

Practice Schedules

Please note that practice times and locations vary throughout the year. Athletes are advised to check the Titans website Google Calendar regularly.

Cancellations occur when pools become unavailable due to a variety of reasons, most often beyond our control. Many pools are used on weekends for swim, synchro and dive meets as well as other events. Titans Water Polo reserves the right to occasionally cancel practices or collapse practices into mixed-group practices to minimize pool and coaching costs, especially when attendance is low (e.g., when teams are at out-of-town tournaments and towards end of season). Replacement practices are offered where feasible.

Titans Water Polo makes every effort to provide practices during time slots which are reasonable for most of our athletes. Planning for each season starts well before the previous season ends; in fact, we continually lobby all pools for more and better time slots throughout the year. However, most pools have limited time slots available. Also, some pools are considerably more expensive to rent than others.

Supervision

Athletes are supervised by Titans Water Polo coaches once the athletes enter the pool area only. Full lifeguard services are also provided at each pool, as required by Ontario pool regulations. However, Titans Water Polo cannot provide supervision of athletes in the change room area or in the pool lobby before, during or after practices. Supervision of athletes outside the pool area remains the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

Photography and Media

From time to time, the Club requires photographs of our athletes. These could be used for purposes such as advertising, media, in programs at events hosted by Titans, or on our website. Names may appear, particularly if the athletes have won awards; or if a photo is taken by a newspaper photographer who will usually ask for the athlete's name.

If you do not wish your child's photograph to be used and/or his or her name to appear, please indicate this on your registration form. Otherwise, permission is assumed for reasonable use of your child's image to promote the Titans Club.

Community papers are often happy to run stories about Titans activities highlighting local athletes. Help our media volunteers by filling in the name of your local weekly paper. If you do not know it, then just write the neighborhood or area you live in.
